# Cortiva Institute Chicago Massage Tent



On what started as a cloudy, cool day on Sunday, October 11, 2009 turned into a sunny, upbeat race day for the Bank of America Chicago Marathon. A skilled group of 250 Cortiva students, graduates and instructors from all three Illinois campuses (Chicago Loop, Crystal Lake and Woodridge) gave 1,125 massages to athletes from around the world in our covered, climate controlled tent. School's co-founder, Bob King, was on hand to demonstrate various sports massage techniques and Paul Myer, the school's president, greeted athletes and managed the line as runners hobbled to the massage tent, many wrapped in Mylar blankets to cut the cold winds post race. This was the 26th year that the school has been providing complimentary massage at the end of the marathon.

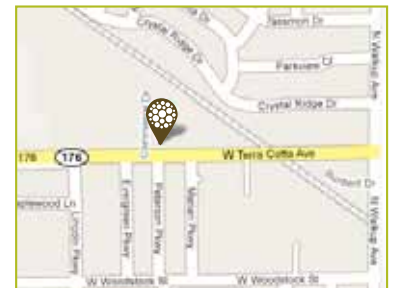

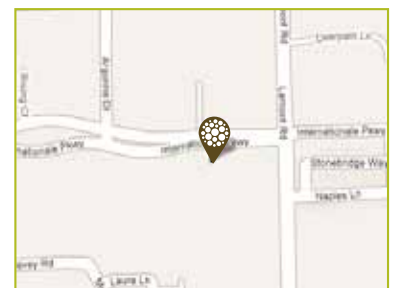
