Awards

- The Founders' Scholarship is a \$1,000 award issued to an eligible student at each school in honor of the work and dedication of the founders of our schools. These remarkable individuals dedicated their lives' work to massage therapy and education.
- The Presidents' Scholarship is a \$500 award issued to recognize the applicant's commitment to their education and their goals in massage therapy.

Application Requirements:

- Submit a completed Scholarship Application.
- Submit a 500 word essay stating your educational goals, career objectives and describe why you have chosen to pursue an education in massage therapy (you may use additional paper if needed to complete essay portion of application).
- Complete an interview with the Admissions Department at the school

Eligibility/Selection Criteria:

- Student must successfully complete all admissions requirements of the program and be accepted for enrollment.
- Students may only apply for this scholarship at the time of enrollment; re-entry students are not eligible for this scholarship.
- Students who receive a scholarship must maintain satisfactory academic progress, as defined in the official school catalog. Failure to maintain satisfactory academic progress will result in the forfeiture of any future funds.
- Recipients are selected by the scholarship committee appointed by the campus president.
- The selection committee evaluates essays based upon the following criteria: sincerity of message, concise writing style, clarity of message, and accuracy of grammar and spelling.
- By submitting a scholarship application, applicants release all rights to Cortiva Education, Inc. and its subsidiaries for the use of applicant's essay, student's name and image or photograph, which may be used in advertising, news releases, websites, or other public relations activities, if desired.

Method of Disbursement:

- Scholarship awards will be applied to the student's account in equal amounts at the end of each term successfully completed during the recipient's program.
